Graduated in architecture in 1997 with specialization in urbanism, Andrea Lorito realized his studies in Rome and Paris. Nicaraguan resident since 1999, he participated in rehabilitation of settlements damaged by Hurricane Mitch, working until 2003 in different projects between Matagalpa, Managua and Chinandega. In the years 2004/2005 he was responsible for planning preventive proposals based on natural risk analysis for 30 municipalities in the region of the Pacific Ocean, in a World Bank project developed by Nicaraguan civil protection (SINAPRED) and by the World Institute for Disaster Risk Management Inc. (DRM). In the years between 2006 and 2010 has carried out independent professional activity, cooperating with architects Leonelli, Romero, Saravia, the Institute for sustainable development INDES and consultancy Group CABAL, or independently, making or participating in various urban planning studies, planning, risk, hydrological basin management plans. Among his clients there were several municipal authorities including Managua, cooperation agencies (Italian, German, of Luxembourg), and State institutions such as ministries of agriculture, environment, or tourism.
